My analyses are made from looking at the PP's, without the benefit of the HorseSheets. I will compare them with the sheets figures and make my bets accordingly.

Red is/are my choices for the win. Blue are my choices for exacta/trifecta. Brown are my choices for possible piece, including a couple of crazy longshots.

- #6 FTS for Santana and Asmussen; decent works but no turf; well bred; \$460k.
- #7 FTS; War Front/Danzig; Irad for Ward; okay turf works; \$230k. #8 MTO.

Analysis: #5 should get in front and could go all the way. #6 and #7 appear to be the main competitors, but the #4 horse will probably be a runner, as might #3 with Saez up. Have to figure #5 to win, but it's a maiden.

If someone gets in front of her, she may give it up. #4 has closed a bit in the past, but figs aren't great. #3 and #7 appear to be the most likely if the speed tires; both have shown a little tendency to close, and have the best numbers other than #1.
