#1 may not like Saratoga; good race two back at Bel; switch to Tyler from Franco; 1st time turf; Saffie.
 #2 1st race; gets Lezcano for Linda; bullet + okay work on turf.
 #3 okay race here on good track for only race; Saez; Malibu Moon; 1st on turf; okay work on turf.
 #4 FTS gets Javier; decent works; Candy Ride and Sky Mesa.
 #5 good 5f turf race at GP in May; 2nd from 9-hole; very quick; switch Pino to Joel; okay turf works; \$220k.
 #6 FTS for Santana and Asmussen; decent works but no turf; well bred; \$460k.
 #7 FTS; War Front/Danzig; Irad for Ward; okay turf works; \$230k. #8 MTO.

Analysis: #5 should get in front and could go all the way. #6 and #7 appear to be the main competitors, but the #4 horse will probably be a runner, as might #3 with Saez up. Have to figure #5 to win, but it's a maiden.

#1 almost wired in last, at Bel; gets Santana for first time claim by Atlas; 3 claims in last 3 races; drops a bit; okay works since; certainly possible.
 #2 also good early speed; switch from Torres to Saez; big drop; shortens; good works since; probably in too tough in last; (slow last race) also possible.
 #3 ran okay in mud in last; drops; switches from Franco to Jose; no works since; outsider.
 #4 looks like she'd rather run in front, but isn't quick enough for this group, I fear; hasn't closed yet; big switch from Davila to Irad.
 #5 drops a bit but appears to have only one race in her PP's that would threaten these; in from Monmouth; switch to Dylan from Paco; don't see it.
 #6 sinks to NLL; 1st start with Potts; switch to Cohen from Javier; no works since; don't see her.
 #7 likes the distance (2 for 2); steps down a bit from a pressing win at Bel a month ago; keeps Franco for Rudy; dangerous, I think.

Analysis: Figure Santana has to go from the gitgo, but doesn't have blistering speed. #2 may try to go with her, and #3 might be in that mix. If someone gets in front of her, she may give it up. #4 has closed a bit in the past, but figs aren't great. #3 and #7 appear to be the most likely if the speed tires; both have shown a little tendency to close, and have the best numbers other than #1.

#1 won last 4 days ago (scratch probable), here 3rd off ATDS against similar; switches from Saez to Irad for Rudy; 94 avg for last three.
 #2 drops to NLL; forgot last in mud against better last May against better; 101 avg last three; Junior stays for Kimmel; highest fig ATDS; likes the front end but has been known to press and close; trounced by #1 three back.
 #3 speed horse; probably quickest; claimed from Clement in last by offer trainer; steps way up; won last in mud against cheaper; keeps Rosario; has been beaten by these often in the past; doubtful unless the others give him a clear easy lead.
 #4 likes front end; wired at Belmont in last against cheaper; keeps Jose; decent works.
 #5 is third off; yet another early speed type; steps up; average figs; closed a bit two back, which probably will try to do the same today.

Analysis: Assuming #1 scratches, #2 is the most obvious choice. Will probably go off at even money. Single?

#3 badly named horse BTL in last as favorite against cheaper ATDS at Indiana Grand; 1st at Sar; switches to Tyler for Maker; not sure that's enough.
#4 off since June after fading against an insanely quick pace; at least a full second faster to four furlongs than anyone else in the race, can press and close just in case; good works since; switch from Paco to Jose; very probable.
#5 MTO; contender if off turf.
#6 third off; moves up; switches to Joel for Shug (winning combo); no works since; third off worked 7 races ago; possible, I guess.
#7 off since September; doesn't appear to be at her best off a layoff; steps up a bit; switches to Lezcano from Franco; won here two back ATDS; mediocre works; don't think so.
#8 third off; won last, here ATDS against cheaper; moves up a bit; switch from Joel to Luis for Clement (winning combo); closer; must catch #4.

Analysis: #4 should get a reasonably easy lead and improve her position. If someone gets in front of her, she can close. Probable winner. After that it's a tossup. Maybe #8 can stay closer and pass her if she tires. If #4 doesn't get out of the gate, or isn't right, #8 has a better chance; #3 might show up somewhere, so might #1.

#3 FTS; well bred; decent works; gets Jose for Englehart; not convinced.
#4 best figs overall; trouble in only ATDS; last two on off tracks; no early speed evident; Javier stays for Barclay; certainly possible.
#5 third off; appears to be an early speed horse without much early speed; switch to Saez, who may get him out; no works; not impressed.
#6 third off; very slow early in all four; no works; switch to Franco from Davis; don't see it.
#7 looks totally out of it; has only ever run one race that could compete against these, a mile four races ago at Aqu; steps up pretty big; in awful form right now.

Analysis: Pretty obviously a contest between #1 and #4. I suspect Joel does whatever it takes to get the early lead without killing his horse; if someone else gets in front of him that's ok, he can close; so can #4. Of the others, I guess #3 and #5 might come in for a piece of some kind.
