As expected, this race is filled with early speed, the fastest of which may be #11, who unfortunately is situated on the far outside. #1 picks up Umberto, These days I don't count Rispoli totally out of any turf race, but this seems a stretch; his horse has been comfortable on the lead. 1, 2, and 8 are all fillies running against the boys, #12 is a ridgeling; #2 is quick, won from the 2-hole against cheaper in her last; keeps Irad for Ward, top connections; lost the Queen Mary by 3 lengths; comes off layoff (26%). #3 presser/closer; keeps Joel for Asmussen; has won 3 of 4, with average figs. #4 first time in U.S.; switches to Ryan; no published works. #5 first time U.S.; keeps Buick for Appleby; presser/closer; hard to ignore. #6 is another first time in U.S.; Dettori jumps on (Ryan moves to #4); in the exacta in all but one of his races; evidently a presser; no published works. #7 off a short layoff; average figs; Jose stays for Chad; steps up. #8 surprised everyone by winning a G3 in her last at 50-1; third off; back to Corrales; don't see a repeat. #9 good race 2 back at Mth; switch to Tyler from Irad; steps up; good works since; exits key race?; did he just really like Monmouth and Rendon or is he that good? #10 has dominated all his races, all 5 on dirt so far; two turf works since; impossible to throw out, also probably impossible to bet; watch tote. #11 won his only two races, both against much cheaper, the last on turf; posted fastest half (43.3) in last, closing; back to Prat for Baffert. #12 has been first or second in his last five races, against some tough horses; Holly is a very good rider for a very good trainer; likes the front end; no published works. #13 has won his last two against much cheaper, gets Saez, and had a blistering workout a week ago. #14 keeps Johnny V for Ward; okay figs against cheaper; okay works. #15 gets Geroux, but doesn't seem to have much else.

#11 has the best figs, is quickest, but can close; he might be the choice based on what we can see, but we can't see nearly enough. Way too many unknowns for me to take a chance. I'd probably put a buck or two on Rispoli if this was Santa Anita; might do that, anyway, depending on the posttime odds.

#1 broke his maiden in last, here against much cheaper after two tries, tries a route for the first time, bred for it, keeps Joe, very good works, likes the lead, and may get it, but maybe not a winner this time. #2 picks up Jose O for Sano; won last on "off turf"; light figs; good works; anything's possible. #3 is a running sumbitch that has dominated all three of his races, two of them G1's, in trip figs; keeps Hernandez for Baffert; two amazing 6f works since; if Keeneland's not a problem for him I'm afraid he's long gone. #4 has done much the same as #3, but with less imposing figs; third off; keeps Irad; his best race will put him in the hunt. #5 broke his maiden with a big fig (97) at Sar; keeps Rosario for Cox; third career race; great works; hot connection combo; will be trying. #6 has won 2 of 3, one a G1; keeps Prat for Chad; very good works; last two were in the slop; probably haven't see his best yet, but even that may not be good enough. Mario stays on #7 for McCarthy; trouble in last two; never been a route; turf to dirt; probably outclassed. #8 trouble in last; third off; switch to Saez for Todd; can't recommend, but Saez is known for surprises. #9 looks overmatched. #10 ran a good one in last (his second overall) with a 101 at SA but couldn't beat #3; keeps Johnny V for Baffert; great 6f work since; may show early speed, may challenge #3 for it.

#3 is obviously the best horse based on the PP's. Won't be worth a bet at even money; too many unforeseen things can happen. I would probably make him a single in my pick six if I ever played one. #10 should be close up for six furlongs or so; if he is able to close he might be trouble. #4 is likely the 2<sup>nd</sup> best horse in here on form, and has a shot. My longshot might be Saez on #8, if they let him go off at anywhere near ML odds.

#3 is one of the track handicapper's best bets of the day.

#1 here's Ryan riding another Aidan O'Brien horse; has won three in a row overseas; first in U.S.; comes off 48 day layoff; no published works; hard to overlook the connections. #2 has won three in a row including two G3's, all under Smith, who stays; presser; figs compete; good works since; possible. #3 looks dramatically overmatched; got some quickness, though, may get the lead, and in a turf mile at Kee the lead can be a good thing; I probably won't use him, though. #4 comes in from Great Britan; never raced in U.S.; has won three of five, including two G3's; Buick stays for Appleby; excellent connections; can lead or press and close; major contender? #5 has one decent race out of three, but will have to improve on it to contend here. #6 won a G2 here in his last; third off; switch to Rosario; good figs; good works since; takes a while to get going, but maybe Joel can get him closer up sooner; may like to run longer better. Saez gets back on #7 for some reason; third off; 3<sup>rd</sup> in his last two races, one a G2 here; has been beaten by others in here; decent works; don't see it except for the fact that it's Saez and Maker, connections you definitely must respect. #8 had some trouble in a G2 at BAQ in last and just missed; BTL; Prat stays for Chad; okay works; beaten by #13 in last; contender.
